

LYMPHATIC DRAINAGE MASSAGE COURSE

At the Australasian Beauty Therapy Academy, we aim to provide students with a reliable, and flexible learning and assessment process, where evidence gathered through a range of methods is validated against the unit of competency.

Practical sessions can take place in school hours and in both practical training classes and the Student Clinic. The Student Clinic simulates a Beauty Salon environment and provides actual beauty services to members of the public. In this environment, students are able to apply the full range of competencies against learning outcomes in a supervised environment. This continuous assessment process, which is on going for the full duration of the course, provides strong evidence to support the student's final course outcome as well as a tool for constant student feedback and improvement during the course.

1. DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed for those wishing to develop the skills and knowledge to provide superficial lymph massage for the treatment of specific skin and body conditions. It requires the ability to interpret a treatment plan, and to select and apply a range of superficial lymph massage techniques.

This unit applies to beauty therapists with knowledge of the anatomy and physiology of the lymphatic system, the role of the lymphatic system in wound healing, inflammation and oedema and the biology of acne conditions. They provide treatments in beauty therapy or medical cosmetic clinics. Treatment may be performed post-operatively under medical supervision. They exercise judgement in planning and implementing an appropriate treatment program.
