



MANICURE AND PEDICURE

At the Australasian Beauty Therapy Academy, we aim to provide students with a reliable, and flexible learning and assessment process, where evidence gathered through a range of methods is validated against the unit of competency. Practical sessions can take place in school hours and in both practical training classes and the Student Clinic. The Student Clinic simulates a Beauty Salon environment and provides actual beauty services to members of the public. In this environment, students are able to apply the full range of competencies against learning outcomes in a supervised environment. This continuous assessment process, which is on going for the full duration of the course, provides strong evidence to support the student's final course outcome as well as a tool for constant student feedback and improvement during the course.

1. DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed for those wishing to develop the skills and knowledge to begin a career in the nail/beauty therapy. It involves interacting with customers, providing natural nail care services in a safe and hygienic manner. The course covers knowledge and techniques for:

- *Preparing client and work area for service, include Identifying contra-indications*
- *Design/choose appropriate colour and products*
- *Identify the different products and demonstrate understanding of nail science*
- *Performing Manicure and Pedicure treatments (include: express, standard, deluxe and paraffin treatment, as well as French painting)*
- *Providing aftercare and homecare advices*

2. PRE-REQUISITE AND/OR CO-REQUISITE: NONE.

3. ASSESSMENT INCLUDES:

- *Attendance record (class attendance)*
- *Written assignment*
- *Practical assessment: minimum of 6 treatment records (to satisfactory level)*

4. COURSE DURATION AND COMPLETION DATE:

Total estimate (including home study and assessment): 50 hours (depend on the level of competency)

To graduate and receive your award certificate, you are required to complete all the course requirements within three months after commencement date of the course in accordance with the ABTA Student Policies and Procedures.
