At the Australasian Beauty Therapy Academy, we aim to provide students with a reliable, and flexible learning and assessment process, where evidence gathered through a range of methods is validated against the unit of competency. Practical sessions can take place in school hours and in both practical training classes and the student clinic. The student clinic simulates a beauty salon environment and provides actual beauty services to members of the public. In this environment, students are able to apply the full range of competencies against learning outcomes in a supervised environment. This continuous assessment process, which is ongoing for the full duration of the course, provides strong evidence to support the student's final course outcome as well as a tool for constant student feedback and improvement during the course.

About this course

This course is designed for those wishing to develop the skills and knowledge to provide full body relaxation massages. It requires the ability to establish priorities with clients, synthesize knowledge of anatomy and physiology and lifestyle factors to design body massage routines and provide advice on body products and protection from environmental damage. Body massage can be a single treatment or form part of a series of treatments.
