

Make-up I Course

At the Australasian Beauty Therapy Academy, we aim to provide students with a reliable, and flexible learning and assessment process, where evidence gathered through a range of methods is validated against the unit of competency.

Practical sessions can take place in school hours and in both practical training classes and the student clinic. The student clinic simulates a beauty salon environment and provides actual beauty services to members of the public. In this environment, students are able to apply the full range of competencies against learning outcomes in a supervised environment. This continuous assessment process, which is ongoing for the full duration of the course, provides strong evidence to support the student's final course outcome as well as a tool for constant student feedback and improvement during the course.

About this course

This course is designed for those wishing to develop the skills and knowledge to apply facial make-up products for day, evening or special occasions. It requires the ability to consult with clients, analyse face and skin and to demonstrate and apply make-up products to suit client needs or make-up brief. On success completion of the course you will be able to:

- Prepare client and work area for service including identifying contra-indications
- Design/choose appropriate colour and products for different skin types and face shapes
- Identify different products and demonstrate understanding of colour therapy
- Perform make-up treatments including day make-up, evening make-up, bridal/glamour make-up and special occasion make-up
- Providing aftercare and home care advice
