Certificate III in Beauty Services - SHB30121

At the Australasian Beauty Therapy Academy, we aim to provide students with a reliable, flexible learning and assessment process, where evidence gathered through a range of methods is validated against the unit of competency.

Practical sessions can take place in school hours and in both practical training classes and the student clinic. The student clinic simulates a beauty salon environment and provides actual beauty services to members of the public. In this environment, students are able to apply the full range of competencies against learning outcomes in a supervised environment. This continuous assessment process, which is ongoing for the full duration of the course, provides strong evidence to support the student's final course outcome as well as a tool for constant student feedback and improvement during the course.

About this course

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who are competent in interacting with customers, providing a range of beauty services which include make-up, waxing, nail service, lash & brow treatments, and demonstrating and selling retail skin care and other cosmetic products.
